DRIVING DIRECTIONS TO THE CHRISTMAS SOCIAL: **425 Yonside Dr. Pleasant Hill, TN.** From Crossville, take Sparta Hwy and go approximately 9 miles from the Kroger intersection out of town towards Sparta. As you arrive near Pleasant Hill town, you will pass a Dollar General on the right, and a gas station on the left. A turning lane will allow you to turn right onto East Main Street. In 1.25 miles you will reach Yonside Drive, a one-way street on your right, just past Van Dyke Village (also on the right). A sharp hairpin turn to the left in about .5 miles comes around the field where plenty of parking is available, though you may come early and have parking in the yard, past my garage towards the barn. Just come up the driveway, 50 yards into the woods, left off of Yonside Drive.
